

Registration

You can register and pay online or by mailing a cheque or money order to the Soundbone Traditional Arts Foundation at the address below. The total cost of tuition, food and accommodation for the six-day Camp is \$520 for children (under 19) and \$785 for adults (including tax). Fees increase by \$50 for registrations received after June 15; payments are completely refundable before this date. All students under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian who is willing to stay on-site during the week. Children under 7 can stay at Killdevil without attending classes for \$300, including food and accommodation.

The Camp offers each member of the same family (two or more children, spouses and parents) a fee reduction of \$30 for those who are registered full-time at camp. There is also a scholarship fund available to those who may require financial assistance to attend Camp. For further information, please inquire on our website or with the director. The deadline to apply for scholarships is May 15.

Parents, guardians, or spouses who don't wish to register full time may stay at Killdevil and pay only for their meals and accommodations for the six days of camp at a cost of \$635 (including the cost of one class and admittance to all the Camp's events). Those who wish to stay offsite can have their meals at Camp and pay for them separately at a cost of \$220.

Only payment in full will reserve your place at Camp. We will refund your entire payment if you cancel before June 15. After this date fees will be refunded on a pro rata basis (e.g. if you cancel halfway between June 15 and August 16 we will refund half of your total registration payment). Apply early – registration is on a first come basis and enrolment is limited to 50 students. For more information visit our website or contact:

Music and nature combine for an unforgettable experience at the Vinland Music Camp in Gros Morne National Park. This is a wonderful opportunity for people of all ages to improve their instrument skills, write songs and tunes, learn folk dancing, and have lots of fun playing music together. The camp will take place August 19-25, 2018 at the Killdevil Camp and Conference Centre in Lomond.

The principal instruments of instruction are: fiddle, button accordion, guitar, mandolin, tin whistle, flute, harp, ukulele, bodhran (Irish drum), tenor banjo, cello, harmonica and bass guitar - although you are welcome to bring other acoustic instruments. There will also be instruction in singing, songwriting, folk dancing and story telling. There are different levels of instruction - from beginners to advanced - for most workshops. Besides developing your performance skills, you will learn the history of the music and various approaches to interpreting it.

Vinland Music Camp offers the opportunity to study and perform traditional music, dance and storytelling with experienced professionals. Most of all, everyone will have a great time together in an atmosphere of fun and learning.

Program

The program includes daily workshops and evening performances. Workshops consist of instrumental and vocal techniques, songwriting, storytelling, folk dancing, and group performing. Accommodations

Killdevil Camp and Conference Centre is located at Lomond, about a half hour drive north of Deer Lake, off the road to Woody Point - ten minutes west from the turnoff at Wiltondale in Gros Morne National Park. The Camp consists of a main lodge, eleven cabins with shared accommodations, dining hall, two conference centres, an A-frame chapel, outdoor swimming pool, basketball court, and 32 acres of fields. The Lomond Campsite is situated approximately one kilometre away.



Recreation

Participants will have time each day to take part in supervised activities such as hiking, swimming, canoeing, and sports. There will also be campfire singalongs and folk dancing every evening. All activities are supervised by staff and counsellors.
